AS LEVEL

The General Certificate of Education (Advanced Subsidiary Level) or AS Level represents the first half of an A Level course. It is mandatory for all students of *The City School* appear in AS examination at the end of first year of A Level.

AS Level is accepted internationally and carries half the weightage of an A Level.




- 1. Find a course which closely matches your interests and talents. Take your time to conduct research and ask for advice.

- Which subjects interest me?


- What are my inherent talents and skills and how can these be drawn out through the subjects I study?

Candidates are selected on the basis of their O Level results, Class X, Class XI, Mid year or Mock Examination results and an interview with the Head of the campus and Career Counsellor to which entry is sought.



FEE STRUCTURE **& SCHOLARSHIPS**

The A Level fee structure varies from campus to campus and is based on the elective subjects opted by the students. The City School offers merit, sports and co-curricular scholarships. These range from 25% to 100% waiver on the tuition fee. Merit scholarships are based on a student's O Level results or equivalent.
