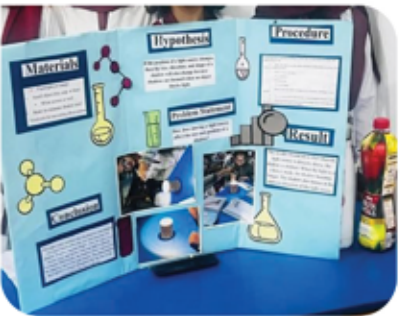
mirrored real-world technology, the models on display were nothing short of impressive. Each student group stepped into the role of presenter, confidently explaining the inspiration behind their projects.

Robotics Fun!

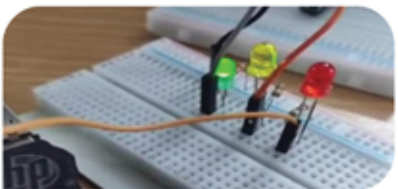
