




OUR INSPIRATION

OUR TEACHING

The Vity School curriculum framework is adapted from the UK National Curriculum to provide a stable platform for the Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE) Examinations.

Through child-centred lessons and activities, our students develop learning habits that promote interests and creativity, independence of thought and self-reflection, giving them the aptitude to analyse and evaluate their work critically and to make connections between new ideas and the world around them.



OUR CURRICULUM

The Vity School curriculum has been designed specifically to create a seamless learning journey from Primary to upper Secondary. The curriculum is taught around themes ensuring children have the foundational knowledge and skills to prepare them for the next steps in learning, whilst acknowledging the need for them to continue developing personal skills in communication, self-management, social, thinking and research. As students progress through Years 3 to 8, they become self-motivated and enquiring students, ready to take on the challenges of the CAIE examination.

At The Vity School, each subject presents a clear and systematic learning journey. Students are taught the importance of focusing on learning and improvement, rather than on outcomes, and teachers are encouraged to use research-informed practices in their subject planning and delivery. As a result, the learning activities are varied and allow the students to develop the knowledge, skills and understanding and demonstrate their learning in different forms.

- Our listening assessments are designed to gauge learners' ability to comprehend and interpret auditory information with accuracy and nuance.
- Speaking fluency is assessed through structured evaluations that focus on articulation, coherence, and the ability to engage in a meaningful dialogue.
- Additionally, our reading assessments measure proficiency in decoding, comprehension, and critical analysis of text.

These evaluations are integral to our commitment to fostering advanced linguistic competencies and ensuring that our learners achieve a high level of academic excellence.



E-BOOKS PILOT PROJECT

The City School's e-books Project is at the forefront of digital learning, providing our learners with access to a diverse range of interactive and up-to-date textbooks and resources. Through this initiative, we aim to enhance learning experiences, promote environmental sustainability, and ensure that each learner has the right tools to excel. The project is carried out through the Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) model. The lessons are carried out through a safe online environment created especially for The City School Learners. The project will soon be spread over the entire network.
